Solutions may be new war fighting concepts, organizational structures, or science and technology. The primary venue for assessing candidate solutions will be USPACOM exercises. Collaborate with industry, DoD laboratories, and partner nations to identify candidate solutions to USPACOM capability gaps. c. Develop detailed plans for integrating and assessing candidate capability gap solutions. d. Integrate candidate solutions into USPACOM exercises such as Terminal Fury, Balikpapan, Cobra Gold, Talisman Saber, and others. e. Collect and analyze data that supports the assessment of candidate solutions. f.
